2	<p>This was an excellent course and one of the best learning experiences I've had in the MET program so far. I found the course to be really well organized and conference on learning at the end helped to refresh and solidify the theories we looked at in the course.</p> <p>In our unmonitored discussion, one of the general takeaways from the class was that it can be a bit overwhelming trying to stay on top of the weekly discussion. You want to read everyone's posts but it can be difficult especially when some are quite long. Perhaps a word limit on the posts (say max 500 words) could help. The thought papers were a great exercise in being economic with your writing and perhaps this could be carried over to the discussion form.</p>
3	This course was very well organized. I appreciated that I knew weekly what was expected of me to complete. The major assignments were scaffolded well so that I didn't feel overwhelmed by any one assignment.
